

- May 6**  "From a circa 1890 Barn to an award winning office space" free lecture by Developer Craig Awbrey at the Saratoga Library (13650 Saratoga Avenue) May 6 at 2:00 PM. This is a story of repurposing an 1890 building, plank by plank. Awbrey, is a fifth generation Californian whose ancestors came to California on a wagon train. Awbrey grew up in the Bay Area and graduated from Stanford University. He is a licensed General Contractor and also holds a California Broker's license.
