



# Assessment Methodology

- Priority 1
  - Meet with individual Property Owners who have approached the HCHS/MDAH and have asked for specific assistance with structural assessment of their damaged properties.
- Priority 2
  - Assess properties along North Beach Boulevard, North of Main Street.
- Priority 3
  - Assess properties that have been “red carded” by the local building inspector as being structurally unsafe.
- 84 Buildings were surveyed in 4 days.


