## RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION

### Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians

**WHEREAS**, the cultural resources, places of worship, and habitation, burial, sacred, and ceremonial sites are limited and important resources to the cultural and spiritual beliefs of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians; and,

**WHEREAS**, Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians has since 2005 been a designated Tribal Historic Preservation Office striving to ensure the preservation, protection, and documentation of their cultural heritage for current and future generations; and,

**WHEREAS**, as part of their preservation efforts Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians is incorporating GIS into their cultural register to map their resources, and still maintain the security of sacred sites; and,

**WHEREAS**, Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians has hosted a summit for all of California's Tribal Historic Preservation Offices to meet and form preservation partners who will work together towards the preservation of these important cultural resources; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the State Historical Resources Commission congratulates and thanks the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians for serving as an essential preservation partner; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians.
