## RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION Pasadena Heritage

**WHEREAS**, Pasadena Heritage has, for 30 years, dedicated itself to the identification, preservation and protection of the historic, architectural, and cultural resources of the City of Pasadena through advocacy, education, and oral histories; and

**WHEREAS**, Pasadena Heritage has played a leading role in such preservation efforts as saving Old Pasadena, the city's oldest downtown commercial district, the Colorado Street Bridge, the Huntington Hotel, the 710 Freeway and the historic houses in its path, the Civic Center, and the Blacker House, and works regularly to protect and enhance individual properties and historic neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, Pasadena Heritage has nominated more than 200 buildings to the National Register of Historic Places and holds more than 67 preservation easements. Through its revolving Preservation Fund, Pasadena Heritage has completed several award-winning restoration and rehabilitation projects, including the Easton House, Gartz Court and the Charlotte Perkins Gilman House; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that official appreciation and praise on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission are extended to Pasadena Heritage for their perseverance and diligence in the name of historic preservation; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to Pasadena Heritage.
