## RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

### Sacramento Old City Association

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Old City Association (SOCA) was formed in 1972 to combat the practice of redlining in Sacramento's old city neighborhoods, share resources, tools and knowledge to promote the restoration and rehabilitation of historic buildings in Sacramento, and;

**WHEREAS**, since 1975 SOCA has conducted an annual Home Tour in Sacramento, providing tour visitors a closer look at restored homes in Sacramento's historic districts, and functioning as its primary fundraiser to support their efforts in preservation advocacy, livability and sustainability, while increasing public awareness of the irreplaceable historical, architectural and cultural resources of Sacramento's central city, and;

**WHEREAS**, SOCA has worked to preserve and maintain Sacramento's historic buildings and sites through public advocacy, including the Llewellyn Williams Mansion, Memorial Auditorium, the Southern Pacific Passenger Depot, and other sites throughout the central city, and;

**WHEREAS**, SOCA continues to advocate for the creation of additional historic districts, standards for the minimum maintenance of historic buildings, promotion of public transit, walkability and sustainable infill development, and opposition to demolition of city landmarks and historic buildings, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission is given to the Sacramento Old City Association for its history of preservation activism, service to the community, and its legacy of community activism and leadership from 1972 to the present day,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the Sacramento Old City Association.
