RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

Sacramento Heritage, Inc.

WHEREAS, in 1975 the city of Sacramento incorporated Sacramento Heritage, Inc. as a nonprofit corporation established to promote the preservation and rehabilitation of Sacramento's historic properties; and,

WHEREAS, since its founding, Sacramento Heritage, Inc. has helped provide grants and loans to historic properties, conducted surveys, sponsored preservation workshops, conferences and events, and produced walking tour brochures of Sacramento's historic districts; and,

WHEREAS, Sacramento Heritage, Inc. administers the "Historic Places" grant program on behalf of the city of Sacramento, and through matching grants and direct funding for qualified low-income individuals, has provided approximately \$250,000 in project funding for repair and rehabilitation of eligible historic properties within the city of Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, in the past year Sacramento Heritage, Inc. created a website featuring downloadable walking tours within the city of Sacramento, including a new Downtown Sacramento tour generated by its volunteer board members, and initiated a historic plaque program, with the support of the Sacramento city council, allowing owners of qualified properties to purchase and install bronze markers bearing the city seal and the name of the building; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission be given to the board of Sacramento Heritage, Inc., and executive director Roberta Deering, for their ongoing efforts to promote historic preservation on behalf of the city of Sacramento through grants, heritage tourism, and landmark plaques; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to a representative of Sacramento Heritage, Inc.
