## RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

### Redlands Conservancy

**WHEREAS**, in 1994 the Redlands Conservancy was established to be “THE Voice for Redlands’ Heritage,” to preserve Redlands’ historic built environment and to conserve the irreplaceable natural and agricultural environments that connect Redlands’ residents and visitors to its pioneers and visionaries; and,

**WHEREAS**, by its dedication to the protection and enhancement of community assets that have historical, architectural, and cultural significance for Redlands and the surrounding region, the Redlands Conservancy helps the community realize the full economic, social, and aesthetic potential of its architectural and geographical assets; and,

**WHEREAS**, through the Historic Preservation Program the Redlands Conservancy seeks to preserve the historic and noteworthy built environment that gives Redlands its distinguishing character, and to foster an appreciation and understanding of the value of historic preservation through community education; and,

**WHEREAS**, through the Land Trust Program the Redlands Conservancy preserves and enhances the agricultural, historic, and natural assets and areas in and around Redlands, and promotes through education a deeper understanding of and appreciation for open space in the community;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission and the State Historic Preservation Officer is given to the Redlands Conservancy for its members’ ongoing work in the fields of historic preservation and community education; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the Redlands Conservancy.
