RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

Redlands Area Historical Society

WHEREAS, in 1972 the Redlands Area Historical Society was established, and formally incorporated in 1974, to support and advance the many facets of the historical resources of Redlands and its surrounding community, and,

WHEREAS, by promoting the preservation of historic resources, respecting and restoring architectural integrity of buildings and conserving neighborhood environments, the Redlands Area Historical Society has helped to preserve the unique character and document the historical evolution of the Redlands area; and,

WHEREAS, through their monthly presentations on local history topics and guided walking tours of historic neighborhoods, they have promoted interest in local history and encouraged the work of scholars and enthusiasts to study and document their community's history; and,

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the "Old House Group" subcommittee, which promotes the preservation and restoration of older homes in the Redlands area, they present speakers and demonstrations on preservation techniques, and through their annual Heritage Awards program, they recognize and honor the efforts of property owners and organizations who restore local examples of historically significant architecture;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission and the State Historic Preservation Officer is given to the Redlands Area Historical Society for its ongoing work in the fields of local history education and historic preservation; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the Redlands Area Historical Society.
