RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

Chico Heritage Association

WHEREAS, in 1981 the Chico Heritage Association was established as a volunteer non-profit organization to research and establish the historical value of the buildings in the downtown Chico area, and procured grants to support a survey that led to creation of the Chico Historic Resources Inventory; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of the Chico Heritage Association is to encourage and support the preservation, maintenance, enhancement, restoration, and protection of buildings, neighborhoods, monuments, artifacts, and natural resources that exemplify or constitute a part of the historic, architectural, and cultural heritage of the greater Chico area; and,

WHEREAS, in 1995 the Chico Heritage Association campaigned successfully for the enactment of State Assembly Bill 1386 to restore and preserve the Chico State University Language Houses, six structures listed in the National Register of Historic Places but slated by the University for demolition; and,

WHEREAS, in 2010 the Chico Heritage Association campaigned successfully for the enactment by the Chico City Council of a municipal historic preservation ordinance and the establishment of the Architectural Review and Historic Preservation Board;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission and the State Historic Preservation Officer is given to the Chico Heritage Association for its ongoing work in the fields of local history education and historic preservation; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the Chico Heritage Association.
