## RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

### City of Encinitas and the Leucadia 101 Main Street Association

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to SB 1107, effective August 16, 2004, the Office of Historic Preservation, California State Parks, began administering the California Main Street Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Historic Preservation certifies new Main Street communities and provides technical assistance to local economic revitalization efforts in historic downtown Main Street districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Main Street Alliance was founded in November, 2002 by representatives of Main Street communities and interested consultants as the primary statewide nonprofit advocate for the principles and ideals of the Main Street Approach; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Historic Preservation and the California Main Street Alliance together drafted a precedent-setting Cooperative Agreement to offer education and other assistance on behalf of the California Main Street Program to sustain the Main Street Approach to downtown revitalization; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Encinitas was incorporated in 1986 from the communities of historic Encinitas, new Encinitas, Leucadia, Cardiff-by-the Sea and Olivenhain, and long committed to historic preservation, adopted the North 101 Corridor Specific Plan to guide the revitalization of the Leucadia community;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Encinitas and the Leucadia 101 Main Street Association have collaborated for several years in promoting downtown revitalization and historic preservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Encinitas wholeheartedly supports and encourages the designation of Leucadia as a California Main Street community; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that California State Parks, the Office of Historic Preservation, and the California Main Street Alliance applaud the City of Encinitas and the Leucadia 101 Main Street Association on their successful joint efforts to enhance downtown revitalization and promote historic preservation on the occasion of Leucadia's certification as a California Main Street community; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a suitable copy of this Resolution be presented to the City of Encinitas and the Leucadia 101 Main Street Association.
