RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

MUZEO

WHEREAS, in 2007 the *Muzeo* was established as a center for arts, knowledge, entertainment and culture, intended to engage people of all ages via a showcase of prestigious traveling exhibits integrated into an urban setting in downtown Anaheim California; and,

WHEREAS, the *Muzeo* includes Anaheim's Carnegie Library, opened on New Year's Day 1909 and the last remaining Carnegie library in Orange County, listed in the National Register in 1979 and rededicated as a local history museum in 1987, the new *Muzeo* project restored the historic building in 2006 as a regional history reading room and research library; and,

WHEREAS, conceived as a new regional cultural arts venue, the *Muzeo* incorporates the Carnegie library with a new museum building, featuring flexible gallery and exhibit space and climate-controlled archival storage area, connected by a 15,000 square foot plaza intended for public events and outdoor program space;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission is given to the *Muzeo* for its integration of the historic Anaheim library into a new museum complex, and its organizational mission to bring traveling arts, cultural and heritage exhibits to downtown Anaheim alongside local history exhibits; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to the staff of the *Muzeo*.
