RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

Anusha Vemuri and Pratyusha Vemuri

WHEREAS, in 2013 Anusha Vemuri and Pratyusha Vemuri participated in the National History Day in California contest; and,

WHEREAS, their project, entitled “Richmond Kaiser Shipyards (1941-1946): A New Frontier in Shipbuilding,” was entered in the senior group exhibit category and was selected for the California Historic Places award presented by the California State Office of Historic Preservation and California Historical Society; and,

WHEREAS, the exhibit analyzed the social aspects of the shipyards’ management and its impact on future changes in worker safety, healthcare, recreation, and childcare policies, to name just a few; and,

WHEREAS, the Richmond Kaiser Shipyards played a pivotal role in the history of World War II and of women in the workforce, and, as a result, is designated as California Historical Landmark #1032, portions of which are also listed in the National Register of Historic Places and are currently operated as Rosie the Riveter WWII Home Front National Historical Park;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that official recognition on behalf of the State Historical Resources Commission is given to Anusha Vemuri and Pratyusha Vemuri for their outstanding 2013 National History Day in California entry;
