


- California Historical Landmark No. 925
- Listed in the National Register of Historic Places
- One of California's original Spanish colonists, Luis Peralta received the first and largest Mexican land grant. His hacienda was the nucleus of the Rancho de San Antonio, which covered the sites of seven present-day East Bay cities and reached to the Contra Costa frontier. The rancho's first permanent adobe was located here; the 1870 Italianate frame house is one of two remaining rancho buildings.





