DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project is the removal of an outward opening side entrance door from its present canted corner location to an adjacent full-length window bay located in the Casa de Pico Motor Court (1939) now known as the Fiesta De Reyes, south of the canted entry way, the new entry will feature an inward opening door with a three step wooden entry boxed landing leading down to the inner courtyard’s clay tiled eastern perimeter pedestrian walk.
